You have incorrect wording in the first paragraph in the Agricultural Use Requirements box on your proposed label. That paragraph must contain the exact wording of the paragraph shown as "2" in Section F on Part 2 of the Project Worksheet in Supplement Three-A to PR Notice 93-7.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Clean Crop THIABENDAZOLE will not protect seed pieces from other diseases such as soft rot and black leg nor will it protect against diseases established on or within the tuber.

Apply 1 lb. of Clean Crop THIABENDAZOLE per 100 lbs. of cut seed. Apply uniformly immediately after cutting. Plant as soon after treatment as possible. If storage is necessary, spread out to dry in a cool storage
