LINDANE 25 WP is a microfine wettable powder agricultural insecticide designed especially for the treatment of seeds against wireworms, seed corn maggots, and certain other soil-borne insects. It contains an effective binding agent to help hold the Lindane on the seeds during sacking, storing, and planting. It is designed for wet application through slurry treaters.

ONLY SEED OF HIGH GERMINATION with good vigor should be treated with Lindane. Poor seed may suffer greater injury. It is suggested that seed be treated not over six weeks before planting. What effect prolonged storage has on germination has not been definitely established. Treatments should be stored in a dry place until they are to be used. Excess moisture may evaporate. If seed is stored when wet, it may develop whiching rot and mold.

IF SOIL TEMPERATURE IS EXTREMELY HIGH due to hot weather, midday planting, or other reasons, reduce recommended dosage by one half. Where seed decay occurs, due to soil organisms combine with a protective fungicide.
