What effect prolonged storage has on germination has not been definitely established. Treated seed should be stored in a dry place until planted so that excess moisture may evaporate. If seed is stacked when wel, heat may develop which impairs germination.

If soll temperature is extremely high due to hot weather, midsummer planting, or other reasons, reduce recommended dosages by one-half. Where seed decay occurs due to soil organisms, combine with a protective fungicide.
