STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

HOW TO USE: Use coarse sprays only for control of weeds listed on this label using backpack sprayers or hand trigger sprayers. Applications should be made on a spray interval basis. Spray coverage should be uniform and complete. Do not spray to point of runoff.

IMPORTANT: **WEED WRANGLER 10%** is a contact herbicide that kills all of the green plant tissue. Be careful when treating weeds not to spray surrounding desirable trees or nearby plants as they will also be killed. Also avoid spraying under conditions involving potential fire to desirable
