GENERAL INFORMATION

DIPEL 10G is a granular formulation of *Bacillus thuringiensis*, variety *kurstaki*, designed specifically as a selective insecticide for control of first generation European Corn Borer infesting seed and field corn. For practical determinations of active ingredient, DIPEL 10G can be expressed as 10% formula of DIPEL WP.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, state or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.

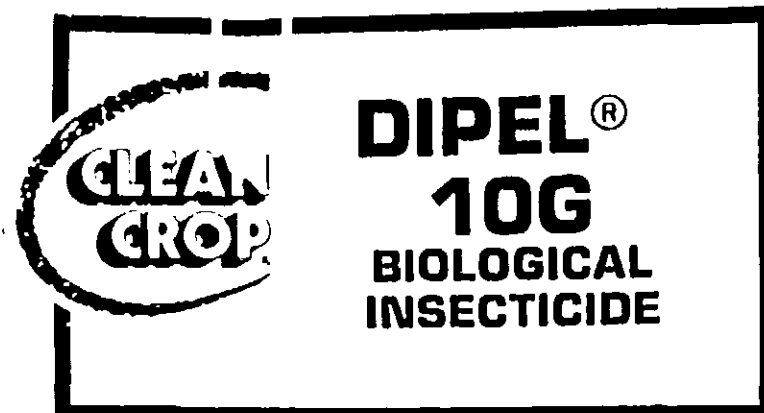

Seed Corn, Field Corn, Popcorn, and Sweet Corn	European Corn Borer (<i>Ostrinia nubilalis</i>) First Generation	1 lb./Acre

Apply DIPEL 10G directly to corn whorls using ground aerial application. Treat corn whorls when most of plants show shoot hole feeding in the whorls and field corn when silks are out. Do not apply when silks are out and plants are past the milk stage. Satisfactory control can be expected if the corn is not damaged to higher injury levels or after larvae have begun starling.

The active ingredient, *Bacillus thuringiensis*, is a soil microorganism which is highly resistant to heat and chemicals. It is a natural enemy of many insects. Corn whorls are the most susceptible part of the corn plant. After the corn whorls are treated, the corn plant will continue to grow from the feeding damage made by the larvae.
