The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

- For all subject products under Note to Physician insert 1. the wording by injection into the phrase "Atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal."
- For those products recommending direct application under 2. cattle instructions modify the statement, "repeat as necessary" to read, "Repeat as necessary but not more often than every 14 days."
- For Clean Crop Co-Ral Animal Insecticide 1% Shaker Can, 3. EPA Registration No. 34704-268, add the following statement under the subheading Restriction:

Persons treating animals should avoid repeated direct contact with skin or inhalation with dust.

- For RL2 Dust Contains Co-Ral, EPA Reg. No. 34704-269 and Co-Ral Animal Insecticide 1% Bulk Dust, EPA Reg. No. 34704-267, add the following statement under the dust bag directions for use:
  - Manage the dispenser bag so as not to apply more than 1 oz dust per animal per day.

5. The instruction for "Reducing Face Fly Populations" and "Installation of Dust Bags" for RL2 Dust Contains Co-Ral should also appear under the dust bag instruction for Co-Ral Animal Insecticide 1% Bulk Dust.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The current Confidential Statement of Formulas (CSFs) submitted for the above mentioned products and dated December 13, 1989 are acceptable and have been placed in the record file for each subject product.
