Protect cloth or burlap bags from weather.</p> <p>Hang the bag so the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the top line of the cage. For protection of face flies, the bags must be located so the cattle will use them daily and must be hung to insure the faces of the cattle will be dusted.</p> <p>Precaution: Suspend up to gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed, or minerals. Bags may also be suspended in front of protected mineral feeders. For blocking dairy pens, bags may be suspended in milking barn exits.</p> <p>Free Choice: Hang bags in feeding sheds, feeding pens, feedlots, near watering holes or near areas where cattle gather daily.</p> <p>Feed Rations: Apply approximately 2 oz. of dust by shaker can, rotary feeder or by spoon to the alfalfa, hay, milk and pulp, and to the face. Rub in lightly to carry the dust beneath the hair, but do not apply with bare hands. Use dust mix or other protective glove. Repeat as necessary.</p>
