## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Change to clean clothing daily. Avoid contamination of food and feed.

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If on Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

If in Eyes: Flush with water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.

If Swallowed: Induce vomiting by drinking 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger or blunt object. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible, cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use 2-PAM, opiates, or cholinesterase-inhibiting drugs.

### Personal Protective Equipment:

Applicators and other handlers must wear: long-sleeved shirt and long pants, waterproof gloves and shoes plus socks.

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning and maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

### Engineering controls statements:

When handlers use closed systems, enclosed cabs, or aircraft in a manner that meets with requirements listed in the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) for agricultural pesticides (40 CFR 170.240 (d) (4-6)), the handler PPE requirements may be reduced or modified as specified in the WPS.

### AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE) and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 12 hours.

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in cool, dry place in original container. Protect from excessive heat. Once opened, do not store bag for prolonged period. In case of puncture, use overslip bag and securely close. Do not reuse container.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

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Subsequent plantings of food and feed crops in treated soil must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl label(s).

## EUROPEAN CORN BORER

For the control of European Corn Borer on Corn, use 10% SEVIN GRANULES at the rate of 15 to 20 pounds per acre (or 3 to 4 pounds per 1/5 acre). Make first application when insects or their damage appear. Repeat as necessary. DO NOT apply within seven days of harvest. Consult your state agricultural experiment station for proper timing of treatments.

**TURF INSECTS:** Treat the turf evenly and thoroughly at the rate of two pounds of this product for each 1,000 square feet to control ants, bluegrass billbug, chinch bugs, cutworms, earwigs, fall armyworms, leafhoppers, millipedes, mosquitoes, sod webworms (lawn moths), white grubs (such as Japanese beetle, chater beetle, *Phyllophaga* spp., and green June beetle grubs).

For white grubs, application should be made when grubs are feeding near the soil surface, usually during late March through May or July to early September, or as recommended by local agricultural extension agents.

**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:** For best results cut lawn close, remove clippings, and water thoroughly before treatment. Apply with a spreader for uniform coverage. Work granules in with a coarse water spray after treatment. Repeat two to three weeks later if necessary.

Use two pounds of this product per 1,000 square feet of recreational area, lawn, roadway or path borders infested with ticks. Work granules into vegetative cover with a coarse spray. Repeat two to three weeks later if necessary.
