The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Under **Note to Physician** insert the wording **by injection** into the phrase "Atropine sulfate **by injection** is antidotal."
2. Under cattle instructions, modify the statement "**repeat as necessary**" as follows: "**Repeat as necessary but not more than often than every 14 days.**"

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

The current Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated December 13, 1989 lists **diatomaceous earth** and **magnesium silicate**, two components which were not present in the last accepted CSF dated August 6, 1986. This would indicate an alternate formulation. Any alternate formulations should be submitted to the Agency as an amendment under separate cover. Please explain.
