Cattle (Dairy and Beef)	Horn Flies Lice	DIRECT APPLICATION: Apply not more than 2 oz./animal. Dust evenly into the hair over the head, neck, shoulders, back and tailhead. Repeat as necessary but not more often than every 14 days. No interval is required between treatment and use of meat or milk as food.
Swine	Lice	DIRECT APPLICATION: Apply not more than 1 oz./animal as a uniform coat to the shoulders and back. Repeat as necessary, but not more than once every 10 days. No interval is required between treatment and use of meat as food. BEDDING TREATMENT: Apply 2 oz.* uniformly over each 30 square feet of fresh, dry bedding. Repeat as necessary, but not more than once every 10 days. DIRECT APPLICATION AND BEDDING TREATMENT: In severe infestations, both individual animals and the bedding may be treated as directed above.
Horses	Horn Flies	DIRECT APPLICATION: Apply not more than 2 oz./animal. Dust evenly into the hair over the head, neck, shoulders, back and tailhead. Repeat as necessary.

*NOTE: 1 oz. of this material equals approximately three level tablespoons.

APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS

The use of mechanical dusters is prohibited.

Entry Restrictions: Do not enter treated areas or allow contact with treated animals until dusts have settled.

Individuals must limit the number animals they can treat per day with a shaker can to no more than 25 and the area of swine bedding that they can treat per day to 1,000 sq. ft.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

For external insecticidal use on above specified animals. Do not treat areas such as drinking cups, mangers, or troughs, where livestock feed.
