PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, is: coveralls, chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, and shoes plus socks.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep away from fire and sparks.

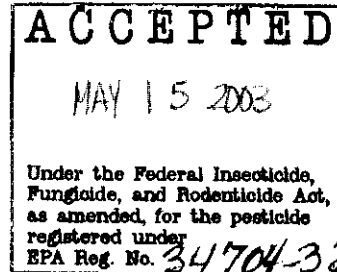
Keep out of reach of children and animals. Store in original containers only. Store in a cool, dry place and avoid excess heat. Carefully open containers. After partial use, fold and roll back bags, clamp and close tightly. Do not put concentrate or dilute material into food or drink containers. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

In case of spill, avoid contact, isolate area and keep out animals and unprotected persons. Confine spills.

To confine spill: If liquid, dike surrounding area or absorb with sand, cat litter or commercial clay. If dry material, cover to prevent dispersal. Place damaged package in a holding container. Identify contents.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Fill tank with approximately 1/3 to 2/3 total amount water needed. Start agitation and add sulfur while maintaining agitation.

Applications of spray or dusting materials containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures. Applications of sulfur should not be made two weeks before or after the application of an oil spray.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

APPLES: Cedar-apple Rust, Powdery Mildew and Scab-Apply 6 pounds product per 100 gallons of water by ground application during the bloom, petal fall and shuck fall stages of growth. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals (in accordance with local recommendations).

PEACHES: Brown Rot and Scab-Apply 6 pounds product per 100 gallons of water by ground application during the bloom, petal fall and shuck fall stages of growth. Apply at 7 to 14 day intervals (in accordance with local recommendations).
