Dear Mr. Dunlap:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the Worker Protection Standards sections of label as directed in the Agency letter dated May 17, 1994 and signed by Jim Tompkins.
2. In the directions for use on citrus and olives, revise the second paragraph to, "...compatible with a wettable powder material, for example, Malathion 25 Spray for use only on citrus, and products used for the correction of minor element deficiencies in citrus and olives.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

### AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**CITRUS AND OLIVES:** This product is an emulsive spray oil for use on citrus at 1 1/2-1 3/4 gallons per 100 gallons of spray for the control of citrus red mite, red, yellow, black, purple and citricola scale. It may also be used at 1 2/3 to 2 gallons per 100 gallons as a summer spray in the control of parlatoria and oleander scales on olives.

Special attention has been given in the formulation of this product to make it compatible with a wettable powder material such as Malathion 25 Spray, and products used for the correction of minor nutrient deficiencies.

**MIXING DIRECTIONS:** Before using this product, be sure the spray tank is clean and contains just enough water to cover the agitator shaft.

If an injector is used, first add 25 to 50 gallons of water to tank with engine running to provide good pressure. Then put injector suction tube into the measured amount of spray oil, opening injector valve to allow the oil to be sucked into the tank. Then fill the tank with water. With enough water in tank to cover agitator shaft and with shaft in motion, add desired amount of this material for full tank. Pump this mixture through the overflow and back into tank for about two minutes to insure proper emulsification. Fill with water, adding other desired materials as tank is filling. Keep agitator running at all times. Sufficient agitation must be present to insure proper emulsification at all times.

Do not use this material if it does not emulsify.

**USAGE CAUTIONS:** Use efficient equipment of the proper type; avoid spraying during or immediately prior to hot or freezing weather, hot dry winds, rain or other unsuitable conditions; avoid overspraying or doublespraying. Plants should be sprayed only when in vigorous condition and when their moisture condition is suitable.

Do not make oil spray applications within 10 days to two weeks prior to or after applications of Sulphur or a dinitro product.

Do not use in undiluted form.

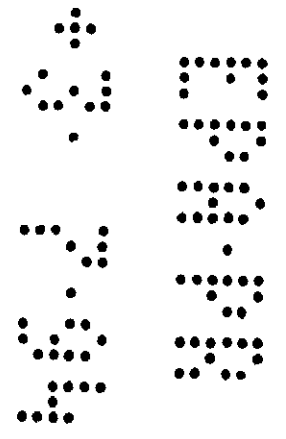

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a

**General:** Use spray as a spot treatment to control cockroaches,  
water bugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed  
below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas  
where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet.

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**To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Sowbugs:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas including pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product. Treat pets with a registered Flea & Tick Control product before allowing them to enter treated areas.

**Flies and Mosquitoes:** Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces, window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (including under eaves) on porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.
