C-O-C-S 15 SULFUR 25 DUST is a product containing sulfur and copper oxychloride sulfate, a fixed neutral copper.

Application of material containing sulfur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures.

GRAPES: Powdery Mildew, Bunch Rots-Use 20 pound per acre. Apply at the time of berries begin to touch and thereafter as needed. For disease control the material must be applied before the disease appears.

Concord and other Labrusca type grapes may be injured by sulfur. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or your State Agricultural Extension Service for additional information consistent with directions on this label.
