The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Within the **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**, subsection entitled "**APPLICATIONS**" revise the third (3rd) paragraph starting with "This product can be mixed with the following synthetic pyrethroids...." to the following:

"This product can be mixed with" insert all listed intended tank mix product names here "in accordance with the more restrictive of label limitations and precautions. No label dosage rates should be exceeded. This product cannot be mixed with any product containing a label prohibition against such mixing."
