PRECAUTIONAL STATEMENTS

POISONOUS Symptoms:
Irritation of the skin, eyes, nose, throat, and lungs. Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal pain. Headache, dizziness, and weakness. In severe cases, respiratory distress, muscle twitching, and convulsions may occur.

Sweet Potatoes Aphids, Leafhoppers, Leafminers, Spider Mites, Siren Bugs, Apply 2.0 to 3.4 pint per acre. Do not apply within 15 days of harvest.

Tobacco Aphids, Flea Beetles, Sucking, Apply 1.2 pint per acre. Do not apply within 5 days of curing. Avoid contact with plant surfaces when priming or curing tobacco. When necessary to enter treated fields within 24 hours after application, protective clothing should be worn.

Tomatoes Aphids, Baster Beetle, Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetle, Grasshoppers, Leaf Footed Bugs, Leafhoppers, Leafminers, Spider Mites, Siren Bugs, Thrips, Wire Fleas, Apply 1.3 to 2.0 pint per acre. Armyworm, Banded Cucumber Beetle, Looper, Mites, Plant Borer, Tomato Pinworm, Vegetable Weevils, Apply 2.3 to 4.1 pint per acre. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest. Rates over 3.4 pint per acre, do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

Turnips Aphids, Armyworm, Cucumber Flea Beetle, Mite, Flea Beetle, Spider Bug, Flea Beetle, Harebeetle, H. B. G. Imported, Cabbage Looper, Flea Beetle, Leafminer, Cabbage Weevils, Apply 1.3 to 2.0 pint per acre. Leafminers, Cabbage Looper, Apply 2.0 pint per acre. Do not apply within 21 days of harvest.
