NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Thiosulfan is a central nervous system stimulant absorbable by mouth. It may cause convulsions. There is no specific antidote. Diazepam by injection is the drug of choice. Phenobarbital may be used additionally. A neuromuscular blocking agent may be used if used only if complete control of respiration can be maintained. Epinephrine derivatives are contraindicated. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas in wetlands. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Aquatic life are important resources. This product must not be used in areas where important aquatic life are present. Contact your State Fish and Game Agency before applying this product.
