

50% MALATHION INSECT SPRAY

Read entire label. Use strictly in accordance with label cautions, warnings and directions.

50% Malathion Insect Spray gives control of many common garden insects. Spray thoroughly to cover both upper and lower leaf surfaces and all infested portions of plants. Do not store diluted spray. Make new dilution for every use. Application may be made with any type of garden sprayer.

DOGS & CATS: Fleas, lice and ticks: Apply 1 oz. of 50% Malathion Insect Spray per gallon of water in a hand sprayer. Thoroughly wet the animal, keeping the solution out of the pet's eyes. If the animal is confined to an area which is free of fleas, one treatment may suffice. If, however, the animal is allowed to run free, it may become re-infested. Examine the animal every three weeks and re-treat if fleas are present.

Poultry treatment: Animals become re-infested unless the pet's quarters, yard and lawn are also treated.

Fleas, Mice, Rabbits: Remove manure or debris from these areas and spray using 5 oz. of 50% Malathion Insect Spray in 1 gallon of water and spray at the rate of 1 gallon of the mixture per each 1,000 sq. ft. Repeat treatment in 3-4 weeks if necessary.

ORNAMENTALS: (Roses, Azaleas, Camellias, Evergreens and many other flowers and shrubs). Aphids, Tent Caterpillars: 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. Red Spider Mites, Mealybugs, Woolly Aphids, White Fly, Thrips, Rose Leafhoppers: 1 tablespoon per gallon of water. Black Scale, Sycamore Scale, Monterey Pine Scale: 1 1/2 to 2 tables. is per gallon of water.

FRUITS AND NUTS: Numbers () indicate days required between last spray and harvest.

Apples (3), Pears (1), Apricots (7), Cherries (3), Peaches (7), Almonds (1), Filberts (1), Pecan (1), Walnuts (1). Aphids: 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. Apples (3), Pears (1), Red Spider Mites, Woolly Aphids, White Flies, Thrips, Pear Psylla: 1 teaspoon per gallon of water. Apples (3), Tent Caterpillar: 2 teaspoons per gallon of water.

CITRUS FRUITS: (Grapefruit, Lemons, Limes, Oranges, Kumquats) Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Black Scale, California Red Scale, Purple Scale, Thrips: 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. Do not apply during fullbloom.

VEGETABLES: Numbers () indicate days required between last spray and harvest. Cole crops including Broccoli, Brussel Sprouts, Cabbage and Cauliflower (7), Peas (3), Potatoes (1), Squash (1), Melons (1), Tomatoes (1)—Aphids: 2 teaspoons per gallon of water. Beans (1)—Aphids: 1 tablespoon per gallon of water.

HOUSEHOLD PESTS in and about homes: Roaches, Ants, Mosquitoes, Silverfish, Clover Mites, Earwigs: 8 tablespoons (4 ounces) per gallon of water. Apply with a coarse spray or paint brush to window sills, baseboards, under sinks and to other areas frequented by pests. Avoid contamination of food, dishes, utensils, milk, milk equipment, water. Repeat applications as necessary.
