



PLANTS AND SPRAYS: Numbers between parentheses () indicate days required between last spray and harvest.
 Apples (3); Pear (1); Apricot (3); Cherries (3); Peaches (7); Almonds (13); Filberts (13); Pistachio (13); Walnut (13).
 (1) Aphids: 2 tablespoons per gallon of water.
 Apples (3); Pear (1); Red Spider Mites: Waxy Apheris: Whiteflies: Thrips: Pear: Pear: 1 tablespoon per gallon of water.

HOUSEHOLD PESTS: In and about papers, Roaches: Ants: Cockroaches: Silverfish: Clover Mites: Earwigs: 8 tablespoons (4 ounces) per gallon of water. Apply with fine spray or pump sprayer to window sills, baseboards, under sinks, and other areas frequented by pests. Avoid contamination of food, dishes, utensils, toys, and equipment. Water: Repeat applications as necessary.

BEES AND WASPS: Flies: Wasps: Apply 2 tablespoons (1 oz.) per gallon of water in a hand sprayer. Thoroughly wet the animal, keeping the solution out of its eyes. If the animal is confined to an area where it is free of bees, and treatment may suffice. If, however, the animal is allowed to run free, it may become re-infested. Repeat the treatment every three weeks and repeat if bees are present.

PRELIMINARY TREATMENT: Animals become re-infested unless the pet's quarters, yard, and kennel are also treated. Fleas: Ticks: Remove mature or adult fleas from dogs and cats and spray using 10 tablespoons (5 oz.) in 1 gallon of water and spray at the rate of 1 gallon of mixture per 1,000 sq. ft. Repeat treatment in 3 to 4 weeks if necessary.
