STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
If swallowed, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by rubbing back of throat with finger or blunt object. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin immediately with soap and warm water. If eyes are contaminated, wash with flowing water for at least 15 minutes.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: A sense of "tightness" in the chest, difficulty breathing, contracted pupils, stomach pains, vomiting and diarrhea.

PHYSICIAN: ANTIDOTE—Administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance. Atropine inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic nervous system. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which develops in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and very highly toxic to birds. Cover and contain spills. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Dispose of excess treated seeds or wastes by burning away from water supplies. Do not allow treated seeds to be on soil surface. Apply only as specified on the label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place in original container. Protect from excessive heat. Once opened, do not store bag for prolonged period.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site, or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

MESREPEL bird repellent is effective in preventing bird feeding damage to newly planted corn (including field, sweet, and popcorn) in all states east of the Mississippi River only. Blackbirds are repelled from treated fields before they can cause significant loss of seeds or seedlings. Birds feeding on treated seed may become paralyzed; however, the majority recover within a short period of time.

Apply MESREPEL at planting at a rate of 1 pound per 100 pounds of seed corn (9 ounces per bushel). Place the appropriate amount of MESREPEL in the filled seed hopper. Using a long stick or rod, stir the hopper contents to thoroughly mix the bird repellent with the seed. Check equipment frequently to assure proper operation.

Under cool, wet growing conditions, this product may be phytotoxic to corn.

Treated seed must not be used for feed, food or oil purposes. Do not use on other crops used for food or forage. Use only according to label directions. Applications at rates above those shown may result in illegal crop residues.

CONDITIONS OF SALE: The directions on this label were determined through research to be the directions for correct use of this product. This product has been tested for a range of weather conditions similar to those weather conditions that are ordinary and customary in the geographic area where the product is used.
