Loveland Products, Inc. is submitting this notification in accordance with PR Notice 98-10:

- 1. Update Disposal Language per PR Notice 2007-4 in response to Agency letter dated 11/10/2010.
- 2. Remove Unenforceable language.

In response to an earlier notification submission, the Agency responded with wording in a letter dated November 10, 2010 (attached). Upon rereading of the proposed language it was determined there was an error in the sentence beginning "Shake for 10 secs..." as some wording appeared to be missing. Following discussions with the Team 25 product manager we are resubmitting Disposal language in addition to general label maintenance. The proposed reuse and residue removal language maybe found in PR Notice 2007-4 in Appendix B, page iii row 3 and page ii row

We are also removing words such as 'General' and 'recommended' from the use instructions. Restrictions have been reformatted.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS NON-CROP WEED CONTROL

This product is a non-selective herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. Use only for non-crop land areas such as railroad rights-of-way and industrial areas.

This herbicide should be applied as furnished with a seed spreader, a shaker-type applicator, or with any equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated.

For short-term control of annual weeds on non-crop land areas such as roadsides, storage areas, and plant sites, apply 40 to 60 lbs. per acre. For extended control of annuals and partial control of perennials such as Bermudagrass and nutsedge, apply 100 to 200 lbs. per acre. Reapplication as a spot treatment may be required when deep-rooted perennial weeds such as Bermudagrass, bouncingbet, dogbane, Johnsongrass, nutsedge and saltgrass are present.

Use higher levels of dosage rates on absorptive soils (high in organic matter or carbon). To obtain better control, this herbicide should be absorbed by the roots. Best results occur when application is made just before weed emergence or in early stages of weed growth.

MAXIMUM RATE PER APPLICATION:

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The maximum application rate for areas of high rainfall or dense vegetation is 12.0 lbs. ai per year or a total of 300 lbs. of product per acre per year. In all other areas, the maximum application rate is 8.0 lbs. ai per acre per year or a total of 200 lbs. of product per acre per year.

Apply a Maximum of two applications per year.

Minimum retreatment interval: 90 days.

RETREATMENT: Apply 40 to 60 lbs. per acre when annual weeds and grasses reappear on sites where weed growth has been controlled.

SMALL AREAS: 1/3 lb. per 100 sq. ft. is approximately 150 lbs. per acre. Repeat spot treatment may be required when deep-rooted perennial weeds are present.

Users should consult State Agricultural Experiment Stations or Extension Service Weed Specialists for recommendations as to use in their particular area or write to Loveland Products Inc.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.
