### SUPPLEMENTAL LABEL

USE IN CROP STUBBLE (SOYBEANS, CORN, OR SORGHUM) FOLLOWING HARVEST ON GROUND TO BE ROTATED TO CORN OR GRAIN/FORAGE SORGHUM THE NEXT YEAR

### Atrazine 90 WDG EPA REG. NO. 34704-622

**Crop Stubble (including soybeans, corn, or sorghum):** Atrazine 90 WDG may be applied to untilled stubble following harvest for control of fall germinating weeds and control of early spring germinating weeds. Broadcast by ground application 1.8 to 2.8 lbs./A in a minimum of 10 gals. of spray mixture depending on soil texture and plant residue. On soils not highly erodible, apply 1.8 to 2.8 lbs./A. On highly erodible soils, where conservation tillage is practiced, leaving at least 30% of the soil covered with plant residues, apply 1.8 to 2.8 lbs./A. If soil coverage with plant residue is less than 30%, a maximum of 1.8 lbs./A may be applied.

**Restrictions:**

- 1) Do not apply more than 2.5 lbs. a.i./A per calendar year.
- 2) Do not plant any crops except corn, grain sorghum, or forage sorghum the spring following the fall application of Atrazine.
- 3) Do not fall till soybean stubble after Atrazine 90 WDG application.
- 4) Do not apply to frozen ground.
- 5) Plant corn or sorghum the following spring with minimal soil disturbance
- 6) Do not graze treated areas within six months after application.
