### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician.  
IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solutions, or if

these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Exposed treated seed may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. In the event that treated seeds are spilled and cannot be salvaged, completely cover them with soil away from bodies of water.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

### AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) (40 CFR part 155). The Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE) and restricted entry intervals. Read and understand the entire labeling of this product before you apply it. Requirements for this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow workers entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 4 days.

Exception: For the last 48 hours of the REI, workers may enter the treated area to perform hand labor or other tasks involving contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, without time limit, if they wear the early entry personal protective equipment listed below.

Exception: If the product is so injected or so incorporated that the Worker Protection Standard, under certain circumstances, allows workers to enter the treated area if there will be no contact with anything that has been treated.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, is: coveralls, waterproof gloves, chemical-resistant foot wear plus socks, protective eye wear, and chemical-resistant headgear for overhead exposure.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: Protect from excessive heat. Store in a cool temperature below 85°F (29°C), dry, well ventilated area away from flammable materials and sources of heat or flame. Store away from foodstuffs or animal feed in an area designated for pesticides. Exercise due caution to prevent damage to or leakage from the container. Store in original container only. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixtures or rinsate is a

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

## SEED TREATMENT: DO NOT USE TREATED SEED FOR FOOD, FEED OR OIL PURPOSES.

Treated seed should be labeled in accord with all the applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act. The Federal Seed Act requires that seed treated with a pesticide must contain a dye which imparts an unnatural color to the seed if the seed is intended to be moved in interstate commerce. Labels attached to treated seed must state, "Treated seed must not be used for food, feed or oil purposes." and "Exposed treated seed may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. In the event that treated seeds are spilled and cannot be salvaged, completely cover them with soil away from bodies of water."

## PRODUCT INFORMATION

POTATO SEED TREATER WITH BARK is an Agricultural Fungicide in a dust form containing Douglas Fir Bark as the inert carrier. It is useful for treating Potato Seed Pieces and Potato Whole Seed for diseases listed and aids in the natural healing process of suberization and wound periderm in cut seed potatoes.

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting.

For control of Fusarium Seed Piece Decay, Verticillium Wilt and Damping-off, apply 1 to 1½ pounds of POTATO SEED TREATER WITH BARK to each 100 pounds of cut seed pieces. For best control this product must be applied evenly to the entire surface of each piece immediately after cutting. If the treated whole seed is later cut, a second application will be necessary. If planting is delayed, follow recommended storage practices of cut seed pieces in your area. Do not use excess seed for food or feed.
