Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting.

For control of Fusarium Seed Piece Decay, Veriticillium Wilt and Dampoff, apply 1 to 11/2 pounds of POTATO SEED TREATER WITH BARK to each 100 pounds of cut seed pieces. For best control this product must be applied evenly to the entire surface of each piece immediately after cutting. If the treated whole seed is later cut, a second application will be necessary. If planting is delayed, follow recommended storage practices of cut seed pieces in your area. Do not use excess seed for food or feed.
