Subject: Amendment - Revised Labeling
Maneb-Lindane Planter Box Seed Treater
EPA Registration No. 34704-657
Your Letters Dated August 3, 1989 and April 29, 1991

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

- 1. Since this product is used as a planter box seed treatment only, replace the first paragraph under the Seed Treatment section with the following:

Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed or processed for oil. Treated only those seeds needed for immediate use minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seed beyond planting time.

- 2. Revise the Environmental Hazards section as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Exposed treated seed may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Dispose of all excess treated seeds by burial away from bodies of water. Do not apply to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to fish in neighboring areas. Do not contaminate when disposing of equipment washwaters.

- 3. Under Physical and Chemical Hazards, add the following statement: "If ~~surfaces~~ surfaces wet in storage, its

fungicidal effectiveness may be reduced and it may also

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
