DANGER

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks and shoes, and goggles or face shield. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin con-

tact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Users should remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Do not contaminate food and feedstuffs. This product must be applied in a well ventilated area.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

Some materials that are chemical-resistant to this product are Butyl Rubber > 14 mils, Natural Rubber > 14 mils or Viton > 14 mils. If you want more options, follow the instructions for category A, on an EPA chemical-resistance category selection chart.

All loaders, applicators, and other handlers must wear: long-sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks, chemical resistant gloves, goggles or face shield, chemical resistant apron when loading, cleaning up spills, or cleaning equipment, NIOSH-approved dust mist filtering respirator with MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C or a NIOSH-approved respirator with any N2, R, P, or HE filter.*

Persons drying or bagging treated seeds or sewing bags containing treated seeds are handlers and must wear handler personal protective equipment.

User Safety Requirements

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

Engineering Controls

When handlers use closed systems designed by the manufacturer to enclose the pesticide to prevent it from contacting handlers or other people AND the system is functioning properly and is used and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's written operating instructions, the handlers need only wear long-sleeve shirt, long pants, chemical resistant gloves, shoes, and socks. However, the respirator must be immediately available for use in an emergency, such as a spill or equipment breakdown.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Users should:

Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

Remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 12 hours for planter box-type or hopper-box seed treatment uses. Exception: Once the seeds are planted in soil or other planting media, the Worker Protection Standard allows workers to enter the treated area without restriction if there will be no contact with the soil/media subsurface.

Early Entry PPE: PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, is coveralls, goggles or face shield, chemical-resistant gloves made of any water-proof material and shoes plus socks.

Double Notification: Notify workers of the application by warning them orally and by posting warning signs at entrances to treated areas.

Eye-Protection: To mitigate eye irritation concerns from post application exposures, the Agency is requiring that, for at least seven days following the application of captan:

1. at least one container designed specifically for flushing eyes is available in operating condition at the WPS-required decontamination site for workers entering the area treated with captan, and
2. workers are informed orally, in a manner they can understand:
 - that residues in the treated area may be highly irritating to their eyes,
 - that they should take precautions, such as refraining from rubbing their eyes, to keep the residues out of their eyes,
 - that if they do get residues in their eyes, they should immediately flush their eyes with the eyeflush container that is located at the decontamination site, and
 - how to operate the eyeflush container.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

12 hour restricted entry interval (REI) for planter box-type or hopper-box seed treatment uses. Exception: Once the seeds are planted in soil or other planting media, the Worker Protection Standard allows workers to enter the treated area without restriction if there will be no contact with the soil/media subsurface.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in safe manner. Store in original container only. Store in cool, dry place. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not store under conditions which might adversely affect the container or its ability to function properly. Such conditions include, but are not limited to, positioning of the container in storage, storage temperature, potential for crushing or damage due to stacking, and penetration of moisture. Reduce stacking height where local conditions, such as humidity or pallet overhang, can affect package strength. Personnel should use clothing and equipment consistent with good pesticide handling.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Do not reuse empty container. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

SOYBEANS: Use **CAPTAN 50 + MOLY-LUBE SEED TREATER** as a planter box treatment at the rate of 2 ounces per bushel or 3½ ounces (1.75 ounce ai) per 100 pounds of seed.

CAPTAN 50 + MOLY-LUBE SEED TREATER is a specifically designed formulation for the treatment of soybeans seed. Protection is provided against seed-borne and soil-borne fungi, which cause seed decay, damping-off, and seedling blights. At the recommended dosage **CAPTAN 50 + MOLY-LUBE SEED TREATER** is non-injurious to seeds or seedlings and the germination of treated seed is frequently stimulated, giving a superior result as compared to results from untreated seed.

FOR IMPROVED MIXING OF PRODUCT WITH SEED: For **DRY TREATMENT**, mix product with the seed in any commercial or barrel treader, until thoroughly coated. For **PLANTER BOX** method, fill the box only half full of seed and half the required amount of product and mix thoroughly with a stick. Then add the remainder of the seed to the box and add the rest of the required amount of product to the seed, again mixing thoroughly.

Only seed of high germination with good vigor should be treated with this product. Poor seed may suffer greater injury. Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Store treated seed in a dry place until planted so that excess moisture will evaporate. If seed is stacked when wet, heat may develop which could impair germination.

STORE ALL TREATED SEED IN A COOL, DRY PLACE.
