HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician.
IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or poison control center immediately. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solutions, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR 170.241. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exemptions pertaining to the statements on this label. Storage and Disposal, Cont'd.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. POTATO SEED TREATER is an Agricultural Fungicide in a dust form. It is useful for treating Potato Seed Pieces and Whole Potato Seed for the control of Fusarium Seed Piece Decay, Verticillium Wilt and Damp-off. Apply 1/2 pound of this product to each 100 pounds of cut seed pieces. For best control this product must be applied evenly to the entire surface of each piece immediately after cutting. If the treated whole seed is later cut, a second application will be necessary. If planting is delayed, follow recommended storage practices of cut seed pieces in your area. Do not use treated seed pieces for food or feed purposes.
