Treated moss turns black quickly, indicating that the moss is dying. Large areas of dead moss should be raked away and overseeded with Webfoot Blue Ribbon Lawn Seed or other high quality lawn seed.


HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Now the lawn to expose as much moss as possible. If possible, catch or rake and remove clippings.
- 2. Apply uniformly at the recommended use rate using a quality lawn spreader. Contents of 40 lb. bag covers 5,000 sq. ft. (1 lb. covers 125 sq. ft.),

3. Apply when sidewalks are dry. Sweep sidewalks and masonry free of this product prior to lawn watering. This product contains iron sullate which may stain concrete and masonry.

4. Water thoroughly following application.



AMOUNT TO APPLY: For established lawns, apply at the rate of 40 lbs. to cover 5,000 sq. ft.
