1. Delete the following last sentence from the Warranty Statement.
"Buyer's or User's exclusive remedy.....cost of the product".

This statement was not included in the Warranty Statement found acceptable by the Agency. Please refer to Agency's letter of December 18, 1992 to Mr. William Mahlburg of your company.

Please be advised that the Agency is currently in the process of updating and compiling a label manual and upon completion certain labeling statements including warranty statements may need revision.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENTS

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists get medical attention.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container only, preferably in a locked area. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not use food or drink containers for mixing or storage.
PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

This product may be used indoors, out-of-doors or in home greenhouses throughout the growing season, or as a pre-harvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations. Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. This product is Ready To Use. To control insects named in charts, apply to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatment weekly or as needed to control infestations. It may be applied on the day of harvest of vegetables.
Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

NOTE: For best insect control on vegetables plan on two applications the first and second week since this spray is not residual. A light mist on the plant foliage is all that is necessary. Do not spray to point of run-off.

On tender plants such as Ferns and Ivys, treat on leaf or stem to check for

sensitivity. Wait several days, then treat entire plant, if safe.

NOTE: Plan on two applications 1 week apart for best control. Apply as a light mist to plant foliage, stems, and fruit. Do not spray to point of run-off. Repeat treatments as needed for continued insect control.

INDOOR INSECT CONTROL

Adjust sprayer to give a fine "floating" mist as a space spray to control Flies, Fruit Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and Small Flying Insect Moths.

Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close windows, and doors and shut off ventilating systems. Direct the spray mist toward the upper portions of the enclosure filling the room with the mist and hitting as many insects with the spray as possible.

Use 2 to 4 ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Keep area closed for at least 30 minutes. Vacate treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment as necessary.

OUTDOORS, ADULT MOSQUITO CONTROL

Apply as a fine mist to thoroughly treat the entire area. For best results, treat when the wind velocity does not exceed 5 miles per hour. Treat shrubbery and vegetation where mosquitoes may rest particularly around the perimeter of mosquito breeding sites such as swamps, marshes, stagnant pools and ponds. Apply at a rate of 5 to 6 quarts per acre (4 ounces per 1,000 square feet).

To control mosquito larvae, apply at the rate of 7.75 gallons per acre or 0.18 gallon per 1,000 square feet. Apply as a coarse wetting spray to the border of, or on shallow waters of wetlands, swamps and marshes where mosquito larvae are known to breed.

OUTDOORS, ADULT FLEA CONTROL

When Fleas are known to be present in areas adjacent to dwelling apply as an Over-All Spray Mist application to turf grasses and vegetation, under and around porches and home entrance ways, along the house foundation and where ever pets may rest or run. Repeat the treatment within one week to kill any insects that may have emerged. Pet living quarters and also the pets should be treated with a suitable approved product for control of Fleas on the animals. Repeat treatments as needed for control.

OUTDOORS, GYPSY MOTH CATERPILLARS, JAPANESE BEETLES, EASTERN AND FOREST TENT CATERPILLARS CONTROL

To control gypsy moth caterpillars and adults, adult Japanese beetles and Eastern and forest tent caterpillars on contact:

On Trees and Shrubs: Treat trees and shrubs as soon as insects emerge (usually late spring). Treat leaves, branches and tree trunks evenly, making sure to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat application every 7 days as necessary for control.

On Roses and in Flower Gardens: Treat plants and flowers as soon as insects appear. Spray plants and flowers making sure to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat application every 7 days or as necessary for control.
