#### COTTONWOOD/POPLAR TREES GROWN FOR PULP

Trifluralin HF can be used to control the weeds listed above in plantings of cottonwood/poplar trees grown for pulp. For new plantings, apply and incorporate Trifluralin HF before planting at the rate of 2-4 quart per acre by ground application in 10 to 20 gallons of water. For established plantings, apply 2 to 4 qts. per acre in 10 to 20 gallons of water as a directed spray to the soil and use incorporation methods not injurious to the crop.

Do not apply through Irrigation Systems/Chemigation.

All application directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered label are to be followed.

This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.
