If toxicity from exposure has progressed to cause severe vomiting, the extent of resultant fluid and electrolyte imbalance should be gauged. #### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **Use Restrictions**

Do not apply more than 32 ff. oz. or more than 2 applications of Abamectin 0.15 EC in any growing season.

- . Do not apply within 21 days of last treatment.
- . Do not apply this product east of the Mississippi River.
- . Do not apply within 20 days of harvest.
- . Do not graze or feed cotton foliage
- . Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system

#### Spray Drift Precautions

Observe the following precautions when spraying in the vicinity of aquatic areas such as lakes; reservoirs; rivers; permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds; estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

Do not apply by ground within 25 ft., or by air within 150 ft. of lakes; reservoirs; rivers; permanent streams, marshes or natural ponds; estuaries and commercial fish farm ponds.

For aerial applications, the spray boom should be mounted on the aircraft so as to minimize drift caused by wing tip vortices. The minimum practical boom length should be used, and must not exceed 75% of the wing span or rotor diameter.

Use the largest droplet size consistent with pest control. Formation of very small droplets may be minimized by appropriate nozzle selection, by orienting nozzles away from the air stream as much as possible and by avoiding excessive spray boom pressure.

Spray should be released at the lowest possible height consistent with good pest control and flight safety. Applications more than 10 ft above the crop canopy should be avoided.

Make aerial or ground applications when wind velocity favors on-target product deposition (approximately 3-10 mph). Do not apply when wind velocity exceeds 15 mph. Avoid applications when wind gusts approach 15 mph.

Risk of exposure to sensitive aquatic areas can be reduced by avoiding applications when the wind direction is toward the aquatic area.

Do not cultivate within 10 ft. of the aquatic area as to allow the growth of a vegetative filter strip.

Low humidity and high temperatures increase the evaporation rate of spray droplets and therefore the likelihood of spray drift to aquatic areas. Avoid spraying during conditions of low humidity and/or high temperature.

Do not make aerial or ground applications during temperature inversions. Inversions are characterized by stable air and increasing temperatures with height above the ground. Mist or fog may indicate the presence of an inversion in humid areas. The applicator may detect the presence of an inversion by producing smoke and observing a smoke layer near the ground surface.

# **CROP USE DIRECTIONS**

#### Cotton

Abamectin 0.15 EC is an emulsifiable concentrate containing 0.15 lb. abamectin/gal. Which, when mixed with water according to the Directions for Use, will control spider mites (twospotted, carmine, Pacific and strawberry) on cotton.

For control of spider mites on cotton, mix with water and apply at the rates given in the following table:

Use 8-16 fl.oz. of Abamectin 0.15 EC depending on size of plant and density of the foliage. Apply with ground sprayers or aerially by fixed-wing aircraft or helicopter in a minimum of 5 gals. of water/A to provide thorough coverage. Begin application when mites are first noticed and repeat if necessary.

For use on early season cotton, apply when cotton is under 10 inches in height. Apply at a rate of 4-6 fl.oz. of Abamectin 0.15 EC by ground equipment only. Do not use less than 4 fl. oz./A.
