Cover crops for soil building or erosion control may be planted any time, but do not graze or harvest for food or feed.

* For all other crops not listed on an imidacloprid label, or for crops for which no tolerance for the active ingredient has been established, a 12-month plant-back interval must be observed.

NOTIFICATION of the crop rotational restriction must be conveyed to the grower by appropriate seed tag labeling or bag printing on all seed units.
