For best results, allow lather to remain on animal for five minutes or longer before rinsing. Use no more than once weekly. Do not use on nursing puppies or puppies less than four (4) weeks of age.

Applicators of lindane dog shampoos must wear the following protective clothing during the application process: waterproof, elbow-length gloves; a waterproof apron; and unlined, waterproof boots.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool place. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The RPAR Notice incorrectly indicated the language to be used for the RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE statement. Delete "For application only by or under the direct supervision of a certified applicator" and insert the following at the top of the front panel above the product name. (Note: the type size requirements for the heading "RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE" are the same as required for the front panel signal word.)

"RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE:

For retail sale to and use only by Certified Applicators or persons under their direct supervision, and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's certification."

2. From the "If swallowed" STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT, delete "or milk"; milk increases G.I. tract absorption of the pesticide and is therefore contraindicated.
3. Revise the first sentence of the "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS" section to read: "This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife."
4. In the directions revise "Do not use on nursing puppies...of age" to read: "Do not use on nursing litters or puppies under 3 months of age."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until ~~May 1, 1984~~ ^{May 1, 1983}. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
