STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Swim Guard **Algaecide** should be added along pool edges while filter and pump are in operation. To allow time for even distribution in pool water, bathers should allow 10 minutes after treatment before entering pool.

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool add one gallon to 50,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: Use one quart per 50,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add one quart per 50,000 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

This letter is in response to your application to add alternate sources of supply for the detergent ingredient and delete the word "Corrosive" from the Precautionary Statement Section of the label.

The 12 month storage and stability data at ambient room temperature is acceptable; also the 130 day storage and stability at 50°C is acceptable.

Ask your supplier, BASF Wyandotte, to submit to this Agency the chemical composition of "Iconol HP-9." The other alternate source of supply for detergent is acceptable, and no confirmatory efficacy data is needed.

The word "Corrosive" may be deleted from the precautionary statements.

The label is acceptable and a stamped copy is enclosed for your records.
