1. Add "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" following misuse statement.
2. The label for Goldline Genex is unreadable. We are unable to comment on your submission of July 9, 1986.
3. The certification of Child-Resistant Packaging is acceptable and has been included in the record for this product.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply undiluted to hair and scalp or any other infested areas until entirely wet. Do not use on eyelashes or eyebrows. Allow treatment to remain 10 minutes, but no longer. Then wash thoroughly with warm water and shampoo or soap. Dead lice and eggs may require removal with enclosed fine-toothed comb. Do not exceed two consecutive applications within 24 hours. To help eliminate infestations, it is important to sterilize all clothing and bedding of infested person at time of treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store product in original container above freezing and away from children. Do not reuse container; wrap in several layers of newspaper before discarding in trash.
