EPA Reg. No. 34797-3 Label Amendment dated 1/17/07

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Move the statement "For External Use Only" to a subsection of the Directions for Use entitled "Use Restrictions".

In the Precautionary statements, revise the inhalation and skin contact statements to read as follows:

Do not inhale vapors. Do not get on skin.

Revise the "If Swallowed" first aid statement to read as follows:

If Swallowed. Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Move the statement about use on food producing animals to the Use Restrictions and revise it as follows:

Do not use on food producing animals or animals intended for slaughter.

Move the following statements from the Precautionary Statements to the Use Restrictions and revise them as follows:

For external use only.

Do not contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated pregnant or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using any pesticide product for pets. If sings of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. In case of infection or skin irritation, discontinue use and consult a veterinarian.

Move the instructions about animal ingestion so that they follow the first aid statements.

Add an emergency number to the end of the first aid statements, in accordance with PR notice 2001-1. Delete the bracketed statement that "additional emergency contact information may be added to fit company policy" as any such statements must be submitted as a label amendment.

Move the instructions about having product container or label with you to the end of the first aid statements, in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1.

Revise all claims to "control" fleas and ticks to read "kills fleas and ticks...".

Delete the following instructions which may permit misuse: Intended for use on dogs and cats;

Delete the statement "Repeat as required" as it detracts from the retreatment interval of one week.

Revise the "If Partly filled" disposal statements as follows: Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

For containers of 5 gallons, the Environmental Hazards Statement must include the following:

Do not discharge effluent contain this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

Delete from the Disposal instructions the following: "...except as specified by this label."

Note that additional changes may be required pursuant to PR Notices 2007-1 and 2007-4. Please note also that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility document (RED) for products contain pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide was published in the Federal Register on July 26, 2006. Additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide.
