The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Revise the heading "If on Skin" to read "If on Skin or Clothing."

Add to the First Aid statements the following:

Have product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.

Revise the Storage and Disposal Statements as follows:

Do not contaminate water food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store at temperatures above 32° F.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on

site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ON HORSES AND LIVESTOCK

To protect cattle and horses from horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes, and gnats, apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair.

To control stable flies, horse flies, and deer flies, apply at a rate of 2 ounces per adult cow or horse, sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control blood-sucking lice, apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks if required.

ON PETS

Use only on Dogs and Cats: DO NOT USE ON DOGS AND CATS UNDER 12 WEEKS OF AGE. Consult a veterinarian or call the Animal Poison Control Hottine (1-800-548-2423) before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidy and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and underbody. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes or face. Avoid contact with genitalia.

To control fleas and brown dog ticks, thoroughly spray infested area, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, mouldings, windows and door frames and entire areas of floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Repeat every one (1) week if necessary.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment.
