Directions For Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To open: Place can in groove - pry and lift lid off. To close: Place lid on container - press edges down, snapping lid on.

Residential or Household Sewer Systems: In household sewers use 2 pounds of Pest-Resistant Root Destroyer twice yearly. Add Root Destroyer to sewer line by pouring about 1/2 pound into the toilet bowl nearest to sewer line and flush, removing blockage until the recommended dose has been added, or remove cleanout plug and pour dose recommended quantity directly into sewer line, replacing plug and flush toilet several times. Note: Do not apply Root Destroyer through jets or ball drains as it will corrode these metal drains.

If system is equipped with a toilet tank, Pest Destroyer will precipitate in the toilet tank and little will pass into the absorption drain field. To treat drain field pipes, add 2 pounds of Pest Destroyer to distribution pipe located between the toilet tank and the drain field. If distribution pipe has an opening, it would be advisable to install a cleanout plug opening into the outlet pipe from the toilet tank leading to the drain field for effective root control in the drain field pipes.

Storage & Disposal

Product Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

Storage: Store in original container and place in locked storage area.

Guarantee: Pest-Resistant Root Destroyer is guaranteed to control root growths in sewer pipes. If the guarantee does not work, we will refund the purchase price of the product. To receive the guarantee, you must use the product according to the label and the purchase order in Pest-Resistant Root Destroyer within 30 days of purchase.
