STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting unless directed by a physician. Petroleum distillate may cause aspiration. Contact a physician immediately.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with plenty of soap and water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Final Fly-T has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against flies, while imparting a high gloss to the hair when brushed out. 2 ounces per head per day gives excellent protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine mist spray.

USE TO WIPE ON: First, brush animal to remove excess dirt. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and apply to the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Pay special attention to the legs, shoulders, flanks, neck and facial areas. These areas are most often seen.

Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin.

After application, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen. Repeat daily or as required.

USE AS A SPRAY: Final Fly-T may be applied as fine mist over the entire area and over and around stabled horses for fast paralysis. Do not wet horse's skin or exceed two ounces per application.

DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
