Dear Mr. Kittelson;

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. The header "Premium Horse Spray and Wipe On" must include "Insecticide".
2. The EPA Reg. No. listed is incorrect. Correct the EPA Reg. No. to read "34797-59."
3. Under the signal word "Caution" modify the location of first aid statement to read "See first aid statements on back panel."
4. Provide first aid directions in the event that product is swallowed (40 CFR V 156.68 and PR2001-1 III.C), these directions must be consistent with the concerns addressed below:

- As per PR 2001-1 III.G, include a first aid statement addressing the presence of >10% petroleum distillates in the product. The appropriate first aid statement is as follows:

"If swallowed: immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

- Include a note to physicians below the last first aid statement that reads as follows: "Note to Physician: Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia." (as per PR2001-1 IV.A.3)
5. Under the precautionary statements, remove the directions for use: "Remove or cover exposed foods before spraying." and "Do not apply to dairy animals." Place these directions at the beginning of the Directions for Use.
 6. Remove the statement "Manufactured for: Dionne Products Des Moines, Iowa 50321." The contact information must be provided without the "Manufactured for" preamble. Include the complete mailing address and telephone number.
