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c. Revise the Precautionary Statements to the following:

Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled. Causes eye irritation/injury. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing dust (vapor or spray mist). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

d. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to the following:

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If On Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

e. On the application for registration, you listed the container sizes as "1 fl. oz. thru 55 gallons." Please note that the Storage and Disposal statement listed on the label must correspond with the container size; i.e., the statement "Do not use empty container. Wrap and put in trash collection." is an appropriate disposal statement for container sizes 1 gallon or smaller but not for a 55 gallon drum. Please refer to PR Notices 83-3 and 84-1 for further information in this regard.

f. Words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics because of its composition or superlatives such as "ultimate" or "maximum" are unacceptable for pesticide labeling. Thus, delete "maximum" from the product name.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply undiluted to hair and scalp or any other infested areas until entirely wet. Do not use on eyelashes or eyebrows. When applying product for Head Lice, place towel across forehead. Allow treatment to remain 10 minutes, but no longer. Then wash thoroughly with warm water and shampoo or soap. Dead lice and eggs may require removal with enclosed fine-toothed comb. Do not exceed two applications within 24 hours. To help eliminate infestations, sterilize or treat all clothing and bedding of infested person at time of treatment. When used on children, adult supervision is recommended.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store product in original container above freezing and away from children. Wrap in several layers of newspaper before discarding in trash.
