  - a. Change the "First Aid Statement" to "Statement of Practical Treatment."
  - b. Delete tetrasodium ethylenediamine tetraacetate and sodium carbonate from the active ingredient list and place them in the inerts ingredients.
  - c. Change the "Directions" heading to "Directions For Use."
  - d. Under the "Directions For Use" heading, add the following:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- e. Delete the word "milk."
- f. Revise your front panel referral statement to read:

See back panel for additional precautionary statements.

- g. Revise your disposal statement to read:

#### FIRST AID

If swallowed drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.
