PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. When mixing this product for application wear chemical resistant gloves. When applying this product wear a dust mask (particle mask). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Handle concentrate in ventilated area.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing.

IF ON SKIN: Immediately wash skin with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and launder before reuse. Contact a physician or Poison Control Center if symptoms of poisoning develop.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention..

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

This product is highly toxic to birds, fish and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use to control ants, flies, roaches and spiders on exterior surfaces of homes, lawn buildings (including dairy barns and milk parlors), warehouses, office buildings, theaters, schools, hotels, motels, factories and outbuildings.

MIXING DIRECTIONS: Add one full container to one gallon of latex water base paint, oil base paint or stain, then mix well to insure a proper dilution. Do not add more than one ounce to one gallon of paint.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not store below 10° F (-12° C). Store in a dry locked area inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in a newspaper and discard in trash.
