Update CSF/replacement diazinon source

Your submission dated June 1, 2001

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Add a front panel site limitation "For exterior use on homes only".
  - b. In the ingredients statement, revise "5-methyl" to read "6-methyl" (i.e., change the 5 to a 6).
  - c. Directly under the heading FIRST AID add "This product contains diazinon, an organophosphate insecticide that inhibits cholinesterase."
  - d. In the Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals, revise "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling." to read "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and

before smoking or eating.". Also, at the end of this section add "May cause contact sensitization following repeated contact with skin in susceptible individuals. If sensitization reactions result consult a physician and avoid future use or contact with painted surfaces."

- e. In the Environmental Hazards, add as the second sentence "Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes, and estuaries.". Also, replace the sentence beginning "Do not apply direct to water or to..." with just "Do not apply directly to water."
  - f. Under the heading Directions for Use, slightly revise the reformulation prohibition to read "Reformulation of repackaging of this product is prohibited."
3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
  4. Comply with all applicable provisions of the 2000 Memorandum of Agreement Regarding Pesticide Products Containing Diazinon (i.e., the Diazinon MOA). In accordance with the Diazinon MOA you have requested the following revisions to the conditions of registration for this diazinon product with outdoor non-agricultural (i.e., home and garden) uses:
    - a. You have requested under section 6(f) of FIFRA that this registration be voluntarily canceled on a date not later than December 31, 2004.
    - b. You may not manufacture, label, or release for shipment this product after June 30, 2003.
    - c. You may not sell or distribute this product after August 31, 2003.
    - d. The registration for this product shall expire and be canceled on December 31, 2004.
    - e. You will send to every person who directly purchases this product (i.e., to every seller) a notification of Product Recovery Program to be conducted by Syngenta and Makhteshim after December 31, 2004.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The Basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated June 1, 2001 which identifies a replacement diazinon source Manufacturing Use Product is acceptable and has been added to this product's registration file.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. When mixing this product for application wear chemical resistant gloves. When applying this product wear a dusk mask (particle mask). Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Handle concentrate in ventilated area.

### FIRST AID

**IF SWALLOWED:** Immediately call a physician or Poison Control Center. Sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by Poison Control or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth if person is unconscious or convulsing.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call Poison Control or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 min. Remove contact lenses if present after the first 5 min., then continue rinsing eye. Call doctor or Poison Control for advice.

**IF INHALED:** Move victim to fresh air. If not breathing, call 911 or ambulance and give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present Atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with Atropine.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to birds, fish and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING. REFORMULATION OR REPACKAGING THIS PRODUCT IS PROHIBITED.**

**Read entire label – Do not open container except for immediate use.**

**For use as an additive for paints or stains for application outside on exterior surfaces of homes only.**

**MIXING DIRECTIONS:** Add one full container to one gallon of latex water base paint, oil base paint or stain, then mix well to insure proper dilution. Do not add more than one ounce to one gallon of paint.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Do not store below 10 F (-12 C) Store in a dry locked area inaccessible to children and pets.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in a newspaper and discard in trash.
