DIRECTIONS

ALLADDIN ALGAE & SLIME TREATMENT (Formula "O") is used to control algae and bacterial slime in circulating commercial and industrial cooling towers. Badly fouled systems must be cleaned before treatment is begun. Begin the treatment when the system is in danger of becoming affected or after cleaning systems whose efficiency is already impaired. An initial slug dosage of 42-84 fluid ounces of ALLADDIN ALGAE & SLIME TREATMENT (Formula "O") per 1000 gallons of water (20-40 parts per million of active ingredients). Subsequent slug additions of 13-35 fluid ounces of ALLADDIN ALGAE & SLIME TREATMENT (Formula "O") per 1000 gallons of water (5-15 parts per million active ingredients) should be employed every 2-5 days or as needed. Frequency of addition depends upon the severity of the microbiological Problem and the relative amount of bleed-off. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.
