

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

### Sanitizing of Equipment In Food Processing Plants, Including Meat and Poultry Plants:

Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly. Then spray all surfaces with a solution of one (1) ounce of WC-140 SANITIZER to four (4) gallons of water (200 ppm active quaternary). Maintain contact with sanitizing solution for at least two (2) minutes. No potable water rinse is required for use dilutions of 200 ppm. However, the solution should be drained from the surfaces and the equipment air-dried before use. This solution may not be reused for sanitizing purposes.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container. Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. When empty, triple rinse (or equivalent) container and dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place. ### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
