



- c. Revise the "Environmental Hazards" statement to read:

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply PRO "1" DURSBAN Insecticide uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear, using PRO "1" DURSBAN at the rate of 100 pounds per acre. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application, sprinkle the turf with 1300 gallons of water per acre so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts of PRO "1" DURSBAN and water needed for small sized areas. Retreat as necessary.

**RATES TO USE**

Area to be Treated	Pounds of PRO "1" DURSBAN	Gals. of Water to Sprinkle on Turf after Treatment
1,000 sq. ft.	2.5	30
5,000 sq. ft.	12.5	150
10,700 sq. ft.	25	325

\* To Control Certain white Grubs ( larvae of European chafer and Japanese beetle) use two to four times the amounts of PRO "1" DURSBAN shown in the table, i.e., 5 to 10 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated followed immediately by thorough watering to wash the insecticide into the turf.

For best results, treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

\* To Control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils use twice the rate of PRO "1" DURSBAN shown in the table. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.
