

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is in violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DIAZINON GRANULES** is for the following lawn insects on both grass and dichondra lawns: **Chinch Bugs, Earwigs, Ants, Lawn Moths (Sod Webworms), Bermuda Mites, Crickets, Armyworms, Brown Dog Ticks, Chiggers, Clover Mites, Cutworms, Fleas, Leafhoppers, Sowbugs, Millipedes.** Scatter at the rate of 1 lb. per 200 sq. ft. (an area 20' by 10'). For heavy lawns such as St. Augustine lawns, application should be increased to 1 lb. per 130 sq. ft. (10' by 13').

**Billbugs: White Grubs of Japanese Beetle, European Chafer.** Apply at the rate of 1 lb. to 160 sq. ft. (10' by 16'). Water grass thoroughly after application. For Billbug control, apply when activity is first observed or when chewed or brown grass indicates damage from these insects. Repeat as necessary.

**SPOT TREATMENT ANTS:** Apply one tablespoon of granules over and around each individual ant hill.

**DIGGER WASPS:** Apply one tablespoon of granules in and around each individual ground nest opening. Make the application about dusk when the wasps are not active.

**BAND TREATMENT AROUND FOUNDATION:** The following insects are commonly found around or near the foundation of houses as well as in the lawn. Certain of these insects may even enter the house. **Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Sowbugs and Springtails (Collembola).** For control of the above insects, apply a five-foot band of **DIAZINON GRANULES** next to the foundation of the house. Distribute the granules uniformly using a rate of 8 oz. for each 5' by 20' area to be treated.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Do not store near food or feed and away from children and pets. Do not store where product may be exposed to extremely high temperatures since active ingredient will decompose. If spilled sweep up and wash thoroughly. Store in original container and place in locked storage area until ready to use.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL**

Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or incinerate, or if allowed by state and local authorities, burn. If burned, stay out of smoke.
