DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Dogs and Cats: Dilute at the rate of 3 ounces in 1 gallon of water. For rapid control of ticks, fleas and lice, sponge or dip solution on entire animal, thoroughly wetting the skin. Avoid contact with pet's face, eyes and genitalia.

Do NOT treat kittens or puppies less than four weeks old.

For rapid control of ticks, fleas and lice with a mist spray: Dilute at the rate of 1 ounce in 9 ounces of water. To insure thorough coverage, part the fur by stroking against the lay of the hair as spray is applied. Spray ticks directly. Apply to moisten the fur lightly.

To Control Insects in Kennels and Animal Quarters:

Dilute at the rate of 1 ounce in 20 ounces of water.

Remove pets before treating the area and ventilate thoroughly before allowing them to re-enter the treated area.

NET CONTENTS:

For rapid cleanout of fleas and ticks with a good machine adjusted to deliver. Apply to the point of runoff, with cracks and crevices and other insect. Bedding should be removed and sprayed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES: Store upright. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill, clean up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinses should be disposed of in accordance with label instructions must be disposed of at a waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then reuse, recleaning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary approved State and local procedures.
