**APPLICATIONS WITHIN FOOD AREAS:**

Food processing plants and warehouses, bakeries, beverage plants, restaurants, super-  
 markets, meat and poultry processing plants, hotels, motels, hospitals, and schools  
**Limit to Crack and Crevice Treatment Only:**  
 Using a bulbous duster apply a small amount of material directly into cracks and  
 crevices such as expansion joints between different elements of construction or  
 between equipment bases and the floor, wall voids, motor housing, junction boxes of  
 switch boxes, conduits or hollow equipment legs where cockroaches, ants, silverfish,  
 spiders, boxelder bugs, and crickets hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing  
 the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid  
 contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

**APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK TREATMENT, ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

**NON-FOOD AREAS:**

Homes, institutions, hospitals, office buildings, hotels, warehouses, truck trailers and railroad cars: To control cockroaches, silverfish, firebrats, spiders, boxelder animal quarters, distribute Drione at the rate of 2 ounces per 1000 square feet of surface area. Apply a continuous visible film underneath appliances. Treat on, around and behind molding openings, cracks, crevices, and other areas where infestations. Apply Drione behind cabinets and wall at rate of 16 ounces per 1000 square feet of surface area.

**STORED PRODUCT PESTS:**

To aid in the control of cadellies, cheese mites, ci beetles, dark meal worms, drugstore beetles, grain beetles, rice weevils, sawtoothed grain beetles and elevators and granaries. Clean up waste material. Thoroughly treat floors, walls and other surfaces. Apply into cracks and crevices and other difficult to reach areas.

**BEEES AND WASPS:**

It is generally advisable to treat wasp and bee nests active and have returned to the nest. Using force means, with extension tubes if necessary, thoroughly surrounding areas where insects alight. Nests in with your ear against the wall. Drill a hole in the ground wasps, dust entrance and surrounding area carefully one or two days after treatment to ensure destroy nest to prevent emergence of newly-hatched bees. If necessary, retreat the nest, if necessary. Do not use.

**SEWER TREATMENTS:**

American and Oriental cockroach infestations in approximately 6 ounces of Drione per manhole. Use per 200 feet of line should be treated. Treatment: cover and replacing with a disc of plywood bored from portable or truck-mounted ventilating equipment introduced into the ventilating air to be dispersed system.

**BEDBUGS:**

Take bed apart. Dust into joints and channels. If necessary, see that the interior of framework is well dusted. Mattresses, folds, and edges. Picture frame moldings and should be treated.

**DRYWOOD TERMITES**

To protect against entrance, using an electric or pneumatic duster apply Drione through an entry, e.g. crawl hole into attic at rate of 1 pound per 1000 square feet of floor area. All vents should be closed. All wood surfaces should be carefully probed to locate galleries and drill holes to inject Drione. If heavy infestation has already developed, fumigation is necessary.

**FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS AND CATS**

Liberaly apply powder to the animal. Rubbing thoroughly and include the underbody, legs, feet and the base of the ears. Surfaces of kennels should be dusted at the rate of 1000 square feet. Repeat as necessary.

**DO NOT TREAT KITTENS OR PUPPIES UNDER FOUR WEEKS OLD.**

**SOW BUGS, PILLBUGS, GROUND BEETLES, AND SCORPIONS:**

Apply around doors and windows and other possible entry points. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
