## ON PETS

Start spraying at the tail, moving the rapidly and making sure that the animal is covered, including the legs and under spraying, fluff the hair so that spray to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly into eyes or face. Repeat as needed.

## ON PREMISES

To control fleas and brown dog ticks on Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, baseboards, mouldings, window and door localized areas of floor and floor cover bedding should be placed in animal quarters treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals commended. Repeat treatment as needed.
